Lesson Plans: Weather

Weather Report

Grades 4-5

Time: 15 minutes for students to fill out the template.

Each morning the Benefield Tech Club comes early to school to prepare a weather script for a live TV broadcast. A student records the present temperature and high temperature. We also included a sky watch (weather forecast) and the moon phase. On Benefield's live morning show the students announce the weather, chart the present temperature on a line graph and the sky watch on a pictograph. The whole school K -5 sees this every day. Occasionally we do tape the weather broadcast outside so it appears the students are on a remote location. Occasionally we feature special weather reports about rapid changing temperatures, hurricanes, blizzards, tornadoes, snow, hail and the water cycle.
